Athanassios G. Platias is Professor of Strategy at the University of Piraeus. He is also director of the graduate program in International and European studies.

He received a degree in Public Law and Political Science (with excellence) from the Law Faculty of the University of Athens. He also received an M.A and a Ph.D in International Relations from the Department of Government at CornellUniversity (1986).

He has been a Ford Foundation Fellow at the Center for Science and International Affairs, HarvardUniversity, a Research Fellow at the Peace Studies Program, CornellUniversity; MacArthur Fellow in International Peace and Security at the Program for Science, Technology and International Security, MIT and the Center for International Affairs, HarvardUniversity.

Professor Platias taught for 18 years (1989-2007) at the Department of International and European Studies at Panteion University of Political and Social Sciences, AthensGreece.
