

54th World Military Sailing Championship

Saturday, June 10, 2023, the 1st day of the 54th CISM World Military Sailing Championship started with five sailing races.

The Greek crew «entering» very strongly to the Championship won the first race (R1-1) and ranked 3^{rd} in the 3^{rd} race (R3-3) in which the Ukrainian team ended first (R3-1). The Brazilian team won the 2^{nd} (R2-1) and the 4^{th} race (R4-1). The Spanish team came first at the 5^{th} race (R5-1).
