

54th World Military Sailing Championship

Sunday, June 11, 2023, the 2nd day of the 54th CISM World Military Sailing Championship continued with ten sailing races.

Team Brazil, maintaining the same explosive pace of the first day, continued in the same pattern and won the sixth (R6-1), seventh (R7-1), tenth (R10-1) and fourteenth (R14-1) race of the day, remaining at the top of the standing.

The **Greek crew** continuing their good performance, maintained their contact with the top, winning the **nineth** (R9-1) and the **eleventh** (R11-1) race of the day.

The **Italian team**, showing enviable commitment to the race, won the eight (R8-1) race of the day and was placed in the third place in the standing.

The **French team**, was imposed on the twelfth (R12-1) and fifteenth (R15-1) race of today's day, making it to fourth place in the standing.

At the end of the races of the second day Gendarme Tom Carissan, member of the French Team's crew, declared his satisfaction with the trouble-free conduct of the Championship, the high level of the races and his conviction that the French team would climb further in the standing.

Tokyo 2020 silver medalist, Polish private Jolanta Ogar, mentioned among other things that she is very happy of being in Greek waters again after 2014 races. Pointed out the misfortune that her team had in the first race of the day and lost valuable points, but believes that the Polish team will recover.

Finally, Ukrainian teams crew member Yelyzaveta Vynohradova said that all members of her team have excellent impressions of the Championship.
