- 1. Following Reference document the Hellenic National Defence General Staff (HNDGS) /Strategy, Defence Planning and Capabilities Directorate, as the hosting authority for the "NATO Use of Civil Standards" Workshop, is hereby providing joining instructions to all participants, for this event, which will take place at the Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club premises in Athens, Greece, from 11 to 13 February 2025.
- 2. **Aim of the Workshop:** The aim of this workshop is to provide awareness on the NATO Standardization Policy, Structure, and Procedures, focusing on the adoption of Civil Standards in Emerging and Disruptive Technologies (EDT's) domains.
- 3. **Workshop Learning Objectives:** On completion of the workshop participants will:
  - a. Have improved their knowledge on NATO policies, structures and procedures governing collaboration of NATO with civil SDOs<sup>1</sup>.
  - Have the capability of applying the basic principles for adoption of civil standards or co-development of NATO Standardization documents with civil SDOs.
  - c. Have acquired information on civil standardization policies and structures on EDTs domains.
  - d. Be familiar with the NATO priorities and guidance on EDTs.
  - e. Acknowledge the academia and industry developments on EDTs

4. **Workshop Agenda:** The agenda for the Workshop is as per Enclosure 1. The workshop will be conducted in English.

**Notice:** The workshop will be conducted at the Armed Forces Officers Club main hall. One additional hall will be offered for "Demos, flyers/posters visits, Networking and Side meetings" during the breaks.

# 5. Arrival and Departure:

Arrival should be planned no later than 17:00 on Monday, 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and departure no earlier than 19:00 on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2025, for transportation purposes. Participants should plan to fly to Athens International Airport (AIA) and are responsible for their own transportation from / to the Airport on arrival / departure days. HNDGS will support the movements as it is mentioned in par. 7c below.

#### Dress Code:

Smart casual for all participants during the workshop, cultural events and dinners.

# 7. Accommodation, Meals and Transportation.

#### a. Accommodation:

Participants are responsible to make their own arrangements. A list of hotels that offer special prices under the promo code "HNDGS ATHENS" is provided with the invitation letter. Hotels near the Athens city Centre are also highly recommended for transportation purposes.

#### b. Meals:

As the workshop program lasts from 0900 to 17:30 approximately, participants will have free lunches during the break at noon. Additionally, free coffee breaks will be in service.

## c. Transportation:

- (1) HNDGS will support the movements from and to the AIA with two buses, which will run routes at predetermined times towards the two hotels and vice versa. A detailed schedule of bus departures will be communicated to attendees once their flight details have been gathered.
- (2) During the workshop HNDGS will provide transportation only from / to specific pick-up points. Transportation from these points in Athens city center to Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club premises and vice-versa will be

conducted by buses on a daily basis throughout the workshop. Pick-up points are as follows:

(a) The Athens Gate Hotel: 1st pick-up point, at 08:00

(b) Royal Olympic Hotel: 2<sup>nd</sup> pick-up point, at 08:10

**Note:** All personnel are encouraged to be at their designated pick-up point at least 5 minutes in advance. Schedule will be adjusted as / if necessary on the first day of the course.

- (3) Participants using their own transportation means, are advised to be at Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club daily no later than 08:45.
- 8. **Security Instructions**: The workshop is not classified.
- 9. **Badging process**: A welcome package containing each participant's badge and all necessary information will be delivered to them on the first day, upon arrival at the Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club. There is an access control to enter in the Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club main building. Participants will be required to carry their passport or national identification card during check-in and throughout their presence at Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club.

### 10. Workshop Fees:

- a. Tuition fee for the workshop is 250,00 €.
- b. All participants are strongly advised to pre-pay their participation fees, during their online registration process, in order to secure their seats. Payment method; wire transfer to HNDGS bank account (mentioning the FULL NAME of the participant accompanied by the phrase «CIVIL STANDARDS»).

**Notice:** All banking fees applied are up to the participants.

For exceptional reasons only, and after the approval of HNDGS organizational team, payment in cash will be available to Organizing Authorities' POCs at the Hellenic Armed Forces Officers Club during the in-processing procedure.

## 11. Cancellation Policy:

A late cancellation of a confirmed seat, affects HNDGS's capacity to maximize training opportunities for Allies / Partners and might result to financial losses. Therefore fees are **not** refundable after <u>10 January 2025</u>.

## 12. Medical Support:

- a. GRC shall provide emergency medical services of Role 1 free of charge. However, other routine medical treatment, meaning Role 2 and above (including surgery and dental treatment) shall be offered on a reimbursement basis. Any other services and in particular any emergency evacuation by civil medical assets and medical care extended to the foreign personnel at local civilian facilities will be paid by the visitors' country origin.
- b. GRC shall provide appropriate medical units and facilities, as well as transportation means for medical aims ready for use throughout the Workshop at all Workshop sites.
- c. In case of an accident or incident resulting in the death of a member of the foreign personnel, GRC shall coordinate with the visitors' country origin prior. All related expenses shall be the responsibility of the visitors' country origin.
- d. The remains shall be released immediately for transfer to the visitors' country origin. In such a case GRC shall appoint the appropriate means of transportation.
- e. In case of emergency during the Workshop, GRC aircraft/helicopter/boat/vehicle may be used to transport injured personnel in need, within means and capabilities to the nearest/appropriate GRC medical facilities.
- f. Prevention and management of communicable diseases, COVID-19 included, shall be implemented according to GRC relevant policy (https://eody.gov.gr/en/covid-19/), during all phases of the Workshop.
- 13. Attendance is mandatory in order to be considered as "successfully attended" the Workshop. Participants who fail to attend at least 85% of the workshop are not entitled to acquire the attendance certificate.

#### 14. Social events:

a. A visiting tour at the Acropolis Museum will take place on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2025, at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the workshop. After the Museum visit, participants will be hosted at the Armed Forces Officers Club for an Ice Breaker.

b. A hosted dinner will take place on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> of February 2025 night at the roof garden of Royal Olympic Hotel.
